



HOW TO MAKE THE NARWHAL ART PROJECT

Supplies:

- Heavy paper or canvas to paint on.
- paints 2 or more shades of blue plus contrast colors
- Plastic bubble wrap (recycle please), you will want to types, the tradition small bubbles and the long wavy kind
- A Narwhal shape cut out of a separate piece of paper
- Paint brushes
- tape, or glue stick

FOLLOW THESE STEPS

SET OUT YOUR SUPPLIES

Tape or lightly glue the cutout to your Heavy paper or canvas, remember you want to remove it later.

START WITH THE LIGHTEST BLUE AND ROLL YOUR SMALLEST BUBBLE WRAP IN THE PAINT. THEN CAREFULLY PRESS IT TO YOUR SURFACE. IT SHOULD LOOK SOMETHING LIKE THE SECOND PHOTO.

Repeat with a darker blue and the wavy bubble wrap

LET THE PAINT DRY FOR A FEW MINUTES

Once the paint has dried enough to not smear easily, remove the cutout shape.

TAKE A CONTRASTING COLOR AND OUTLINE YOUR NARWHAL.

Encourage your artist to be creative, but hopefully stay within the shape. If they paint a solid Narwhal(Like my artist) then they can wait for it to dry and paint additional colors over the top.
